Camp Evergreen is proud to offer horsemanship and horseback riding lessons to its campers at Windkist Equestrian Centre. Windkist Equestrian Centre is a multi-disciplinary riding and boarding facility located minutes from Camp Evergreen. It specializes in teaching balanced seat, jumping and dressage and features a 170' x 72' indoor riding arena for year round riding. It also offers an outdoor jumping ring and cross-country track on the property abutting Harold Parker State Forest.

Windkist's instructors are licensed, insured and chosen with special attention to their abilities to instruct and encourage young riders. Safety is a priority and will be emphasized during all phases of the learning process at Windkist.

Windkist will offer afternoon lessons to Evergreen Campers 6 year of age and up. Campers may sign up for 1 or 2 lessons per week. These will occur during a Free Choice period between 12:30 and 3:30 on Tuesday and Thursday each week. These lessons will consist of grooming and tacking the horse; handling the horse on the ground, tack maintenance and use and lessons at the walk, trot and beginning canter, depending on ability.

In consideration of the service of Windkist Equestrian Centre, Inc. its officers, agents, employees, stockholders and all other persons or entities associated with those businesses (hereinafter collectively referred to as WEC), I hereby agree as follows

Although WEC has taken reasonable steps to provide me with appropriate equipment and skilled guides and instructors so I can enjoy an activity, I recognize that this activity is not without risk. Certain risks cannot be eliminated without destroying the unique character of this activity. The same elements that contribute to the unique character of this activity can cause loss or damage of equipment, accidental injury or illness, or, in extreme cases, permanent trauma or death. This warning is not intended to frighten or reduce my enthusiasm for this activity, but I recognize in advance what is expected of me and want to be informed of the inherent risks. The following describes some, but not all of those risks:

Participation involves the handling of large animals which can act contrary to even the best commands and instructions. All animals must be approached and handled with caution and only under direct supervision of an instructor. All rides involve those dangers which arise from a great variety of terrain and conditions including steep ascent, meadows, winding forest paths, obstacles, change of terrain and surface on short notice, presence of other animals and the like. In all instances, the riders are responsible for applying common sense. Instructors and guides use their best efforts in judgement in handling participants, horses, instructions and riders but it is not guarantee that their efforts and instructions will be error free or properly responded to by either the horses or people. WEC, its management staff, employees, instructors and trail masters reserve the right, at their sole absolute discretion: (1) to cancel any departure or make alterations in the itinerary as they deem necessary and/or appropriate; (2) to refuse to accept or retain any person for participation in any ride; and (3) to terminate the participation of any person and any program who does not appear capable of handling the program without danger to the horse or other persons. This activity entails risks of injury to participants and a risk of injury to spectators or third parties.

IN SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT, I FULLY RECOGNIZE THAT IF ANYONE IS HURT OR PROPERTY IS DAMAGED WHILE IAM ENGAGED IN THIS ACTIVITY, I MAY HAVE NO RIGHTS TO MAKE A CLAIM OR FILE A LAWSUIT AGAINST WEC, ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, AGENTS, HEIRS, SUCCESSORS, ASSIGNS, EMPLOYEES, ASSOCIATES, TRAIL MASTER OR SUB-CONTRACTED STABLERS.

I am aware that the activity entails risks or injury of myself. I understand that the description of those risks is not complete and that other unknown or unanticipated risks may result in injury or death. I certify that I am fully capable of participating in this activity; therefore, I assume full responsibility for myself, including my minor children, for bodily injury, death and loss of personal property and expenses thereof as a result of those inherent risks and dangers and my negligence in participating in this activity. I authorize Windkist personnel to obtain medical services for me in an emergency.

I have read, understood and accepted the terms and conditions stated herein, and acknowledge that this agreement shall be effective and binding upon myself, my heirs, assigns, personal representatives, estate and all members of my family, including any minors accompanying me or participating in these activities.
